Château Bel-Air is located in the heart of the Lussac Saint-Emilion appellation, just outside of the high-rent district of St. Emilion Grand Cru. The 50-acre estate has been in the Roi family for more than a century, and it is today run by Jean-Noël Roi.

Cuvée Jean & Gabriel is named for the grandfather and great-grandfather of the current generation of the Roi brothers and is made from vines that average 30 years and is comprised of the **highly-desirable Cheval Blanc/Ausone/Angelus-like blend of 50% Merlot and 50% Cabernet Franc.** The brilliant Stéphane Derenoncourt consults on this special cuvée of less than 1,000 cases.
